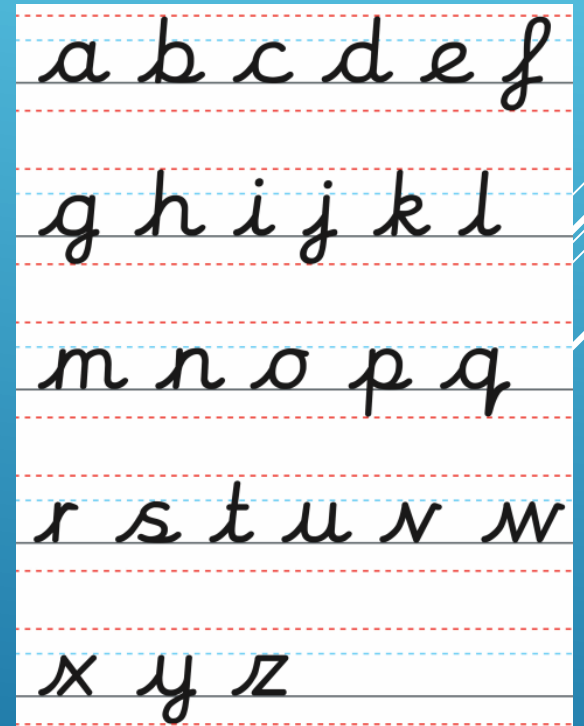

YEAR ONE ENGLISH CURRICULUM



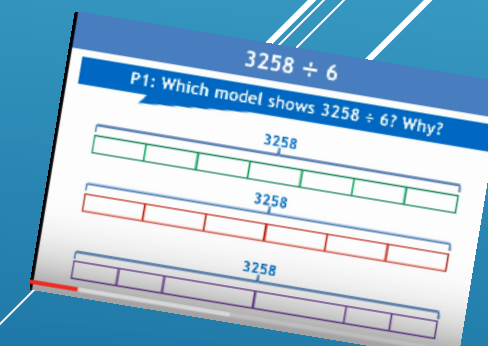
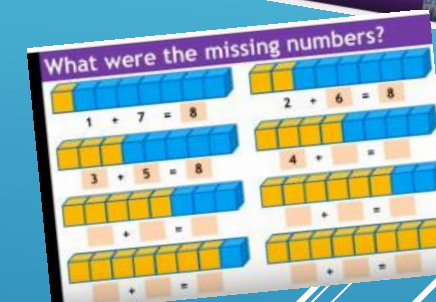
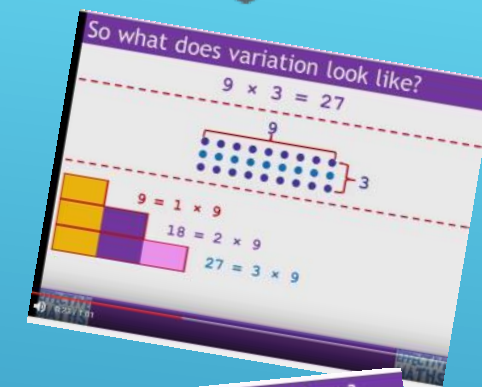

For our maths learning we will be teaching the children through maths mastery. To support this, we use the Effective Maths scheme as well as practising mental maths skills.

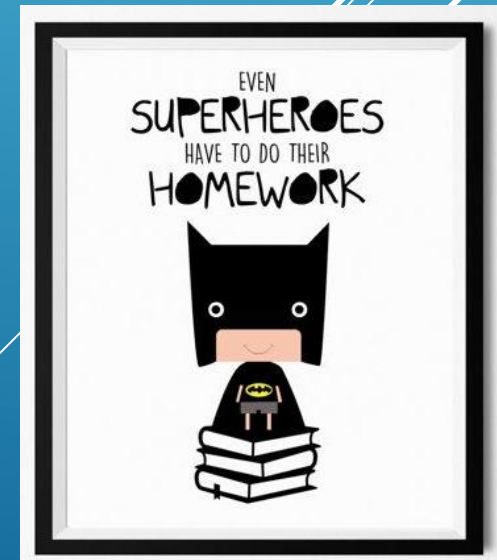


EFFECTIVE MATHS
