Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be continuing our work with our 'Jigsaw curriculum' and looking at the topic of 'Dreams and Goals'.

This will allow the children to think about things that challenge them, how they overcome challenge and to have a positive attitude towards themselves and

Communication and Language

We will be encouraging the children to answer 'how' and 'why' questions about experiences and in response to their learning this term. We will also encourage the children to speak confidently to an audience to share their learning.

Physical Development

We will continue to develop our fine motor control through using a range of tools including scissors and pencils for writing. We will also continue our development of good control and coordination in movements during our P.E. sessions.

We will be thinking about the importance of a healthy lifestyle and exercise and a healthy diet.

Literacy

This term we will be reading the story of 'Handa's Surprise'. We will learn the story using a text map then innovate it using our own ideas. We will also be writing non fiction information texts including facts about different dinosaurs we have explored.

We will continue in our 'Read Write Inc' groups, developing our phonic knowledge to read words and sentences.

Mathematics

We will be comparing and ordering objects by size and length including measuring with non standard units.

We will talk about the passage of time including days of the week, months of the year, sequencing our day and measuring short periods of time.

Number work will focus on ordering numbers and identifying 1 more and 1 less.

Understanding The world

This term, we will be exploring dinosaurs by learning facts about dinosaurs and features of the environment around them.

We will also be exploring Chinese New Year during our R.E. learning and thinking about how people celebrate different festivals.

Expressive Arts and Design

This term we will be creating long term 3D models of dinosaurs using different tools, techniques and experimenting with colour, design, texture and form.

Later in the term we will be exploring our dinosaur dig role play areas, taking on the role of a palaeontologist and working as part of a group.
