In school we will be:

- Continuing to learn our sounds to enable us to read words fluently.
- Continuing to promote independence in Year One. We would like the children to change their books through the box system.

Key learning for this term:

- Science—learning to about taking care of our world and the environment.
- Writing— learning to write journey stories based around the Magic Key stories. We are focusing on our sentence structure and remembering to use capital letters, full stops, finger spaces and cursive writing all of the time.
- Maths—securing knowledge and understanding of addition, subtraction and place value.
