




Learning forecast for Year 2, Term 5

Home-Learning:

Thank you for supporting your child at home with their learning. This home school partnership makes a real difference and we appreciate your support.

- We will be sending home a list of spelling to learn each week. These will be sent home on a **Friday** and the children be tested the following **Thursday**.
- We will be sending home either English, topic or maths home learning weekly on a **Friday** and this should be handed in on a **Wednesday**.
- Reading Records and reading books should also be brought to school every day; children will have the chance to change books on a **Monday** and **Wednesday**
- Please also find time to read with your child as much as possible and note this in their reading records. Every child who reads 5 or more books a week receives a special pebble on a Thursday.
- Children are able to join home learning club on a Tuesday or Friday if they haven't had the opportunity to complete their home learning or weekly reading .
